## **Fundraising and Development**

The San Clemente Junior Woman's Club, established in 1948, is a medium club (22 members) located in the beachside community of San Clemente, CA. Members range in age from 20's through 50's. We are a diverse group of women, most of us with children and many with professional careers, and all with a passion to serve our community.

Project Title: Day of Giving Hours: 150 Donated: \$8,700 In Kind: \$

The San Clemente Junior Woman's Club (SCWJC) held our first online fundraiser on October 20<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic our annual fundraising gala known as The Big Event was cancelled. Uncertain of the months that lied ahead, as a club we decided to forfeit holding an inperson event for 2020 and instead hosted an online day of virtual giving. By transitioning the event online, we were able to re-use many of the gift baskets we had already procured for the gala. We worked with the community businesses that had provided the donations to ensure that the donation was still appropriate to share out and repurposed only items that provided safe and convenient use during this time. To engage the public and secure donations, we used an online bidding platform for silent auction items which was helpful in organizing and increasing the bidding.

All members worked to encourage friends, family, community members, and business owners to participate in the event through social media and personal communication. We leveraged social media to share out information about the event and promote our online raffle of a MURF electric bike to draw people to our fundraiser. We raised over \$8,700 due to the kindness of our members and community. The funds from this fundraiser will be distributed in March of 2021, at our philanthropy meeting. Although this event was a scaled down version of our annual fundraiser, it will continue to provide for our philanthropy budget for the year and we use this money to give to

local organizations and individuals in need. We will invite our beneficiaries to come and speak to the membership virtually and tell us about their plans for their donation in March 2021.

Project TBE 2020: A

Title: Night of Mystery Hours: 450 Donated: \$10,805 In Kind: \$10,000

Each year the San Clemente Woman's Club hosts an annual gala to raise funds to support over 30 organizations including all San Clemente public schools, the Boy's and Girl's Club, Children's Hospital of Orange County (CHOC), Ronald McDonald House, and more. This year's The Big Event seriously owned it's name but instead of a night of mystery it turned into a YEAR of mystery! As a club we worked diligently the months leading up to the event prepping, organizing and were in the process of completing our final touches when COVID-19 hit. Our event was scheduled for March 28th, with a lockdown looming and so much uncertainty around this new mysterious virus our club made the very difficult decision to postpone the event to a later date in November, which too has been permanently postponed. But as with everything we did not let this setback hold us back, instead we rallied together and with the great leadership of our president we were able to secure all of our deposits with vendors and retain the majority of money raised from ticket sales as donations to the club or for use to a future event. Fortunately we were still able to fundraise online through our Day of Giving, but the 2020 The Big Event: A Night YEAR of Mystery will forever be the most unforgettable TBE for our cohort of members!

Engaging and connecting our members through the COVID-19 pandemic was not an easy feat. The pandemic brought new challenges of finding creative ways to keep our club motivated to get together virtually during a time when face to face interaction was not possible. To re-engage and reconnect, federation set up a both a fundraiser and wine tasting event to bring our members together. In the weeks leading up to the event, SCJWC set up a fundraiser with One Hope Wine, where twenty percent of the proceeds went back to the club. This event brought in \$115.49! Members were encouraged to purchase wine from One Hope to be enjoyed during our virtual wine tasting and membership drive. The event was a success with one prospective individual and 7 members from the club joining in via zoom. The event included a bingo game with informative information on different wines as well as a great night of conversation and catching up with each other.
