STRANDING RULES GOVERNING CONVENTION

- 1. A convention fee of \$5.00 is required of all attending the convention, except authorized guest of Orange District, and male escorts at meal functions.
- 2. Delegates and guests shall register before entering the convention room and are requested to be in their seats five minutes before the opening of each session. Each delegate and guest shall show their badge at all meetings.
- 3. Main motions shall be written, signed and sent to the Recording Secretary and the President.
- 4. Debate shall be limited to two minutes a speaker. No delegate shall speak more than twice on a question without consent of the assembly, nor shall a delegate speak a second time on the same question if another delegate, who has not spoken, desires to speak.
- 5. The doors of the convention shall be kept closed while the meeting is in progress.
- 6. Members arriving late are requested to be seated as quickly as possible.
- 7. Members are requested not to leave the hall during the meeting or program except in cases of emergency.
- 8. Members will please refrain from whispering so that all may enjoy the convention.
- 9. Cell phones must be turned off during sessions.
- 10. Members and visitors will please remain seated until the presiding officer has declared the meeting adjourned or recessed.
- 11. Minutes of the Convention shall be approved by the Executive Committee.
- 12. Only an accredited delegate may introduce motions and vote.
- 13. A person wishing the floor must rise, address the chair, give her name and name of her club, that it might be recorded in the minutes.
- 14. One who is not a delegate may have the privilege of the floor only by the consent of the convention.
- 15. The standing rules may be suspended by a two-thirds vote of the members present and voting.

And may we strive to touch and to know The great, common, human heart of us all...


